HDMI port


HD OUT2 port maximum output resolution 8K@60HZ, HD OUT2 port supports HD V2.1. With sound output. HD OUT1 port supports maximum output resolution 4K@60HZ, no sound, HD IN input supports maximum 4K@60HZ.

RJ45 port

1. The wired connection is a reliable and secure way to connect the TV to the Internet. You can connect the network to the TV.
2. Contact your Internet service provider for detailed information on how to configure your TV for Internet access.

Power port


You can plug the DC plug (5.5 x 2.1 mm) of the power supply unit into the mains connection of the ALLNET DS5 so that it starts up.



Power button

You can use this button to switch the unit on and off.

- If you briefly press the power button while the ALLNET DS5 is switched on, it switches to standby mode.
- If you briefly press the power button in standby mode, the ALLNET DS5 is woken up again.
- While switched on, press and hold the power button for approx. 3 seconds; a "Shut down or restart" dialogue box appears on the display.



USB Type-C port

You can connect other devices, e.g. a HUB with a Type-C interface, or connect to a computer by plugging the Type-C data cable into the Type-C port of the ALLNET DS5.


USB port

1. USB1 and USB2 are 2.0 ports with a transfer rate of 480bps. They can be connected to mouse, keyboard, wireless receivers and other electronic products.
2. USB3 is a 3.0 port with a transfer rate of 5 Gbps, faster and more stable.


How is the storage space expandable?

1. Remove the 4 floor mats on the underside of the housing.
2. Remove the screws at the four corners and remove the lower casing along the gap.

Note: Do not use too much force when removing the lower casing so as not to damage it.




3. Insert the prepared SSD/HDD into the interface of the enclosure, attach the rear cover and the bottom enclosure and fasten the screws.




How to set up a Wi-Fi connection?


1. Locate the WiFi icon at the bottom of the computer interface and click OK to access the settings interface.



- Click on the WiFi Switch at the top right to open and connect it.




How to use the voice remote control?

1. Connect the PC box to the TV set and plug in the USB receiver.
2. Switch on the remote control, insert 2 AAA batteries in the battery compartment and locate the "Language" shortcut key on the remote control.
3. Point the remote control at the television and operate the unit using the remote control.





How to change the resolution?


1. Locate the settings icon at the bottom of the user interface and click OK to open the settings interface.





2. Locate the appropriate option following the steps in the illustration below.

4. Click the resolution to select it automatically. (Before setting, make sure your TV supports 8K resolution, HD 8K cable requires version 2.1).





How to connect via Bluetooth?


1. Locate the settings icon at the bottom of the interface and click OK to open the settings interface.

Simple troubleshooting

Problem	Possible cause	Solution approach
No display after switching on	The mains cable is not connected properly.	Make sure that the unit is connected to the mains.
No sound	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. The audio cable is not connected.2. The unit is muted or the volume is too low.	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Reconnect the headset.2. Press the mute button to turn the sound back on and increase the volume.
Connection to the network failed	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. The Ethernet cable is not connected properly.2. Wi-Fi is switched off or the signal is too weak.	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Reconnect the cable.2. Restart the WLAN or place the unit closer to the router.
No picture on the screen	The HDMI cable is not connected properly.	Make sure that HDMI/AV is selected as the TV input.
The voice search on the remote control does not work	Remote control is not paired with the TV box.	See section "Pairing a Bluetooth device" in this manual.

Remote control failure	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The sensors of the remote control and the TV box do not match. 2. The remote control is defective or the batteries are weak. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Point the remote control sensor at the front panel sensor and try again. 2. Replace the batteries or send the unit to a service centre for checking.
No audio	Audio settings are not configured correctly for your TV.	Go to Settings - Surround - Surround Sound and select PCM.
Freezing / programme stuck / no reaction for a long time	The device does not work properly.	Use a sharp object (e.g. SIM tool); Press the hidden button of the Mini-PC; Keep it pressed for 3 seconds; The Mini-PC restarts

Update DS5 Player

1. Install the driver "Release_DriverAssitant".
2. Start RKDevTool.exe
3. Connect the USB-C port to the PC and the player and connect the power supply.
4. You should now see an ADB device in RKDevTool. Or use a paper clip to press the switch (small hole) next to the USB 3.0 port and give power at the same time. Then the device starts directly in loader mode.
5. Press the Firmware button under the "Upgrade Firmware" tab and select the Linux/Android image.

6. Then press the "Switch" button when you see an ADB device. If you see Loader Device, you do not need to do this. (If you want to change the system from Android to Linux or vice versa, press the "Switch" button. Or vice versa, press "Erase flash". A Maskrom Device will appear after a successful erase).
7. The tablet should now switch off the screen and a loader device (Maskrom device) should appear in the Android tool.
8. Press the Upgrade button. The firmware should now be saved to the flash.
9. The device will reboot automatically after the update process. For the download, please contact our support team at support@allnet.de.

This symbol is new RED aligns the previous directive with the New Legislative Framework for the marketing of products. The revision takes account of the need for improved market surveillance, in particular for the traceability obligations of manufacturers, importers and distributors. It provides improved instruments for market surveillance, such as the possibility to require prior registration of radio equipment, within those categories affected by low levels of compliance.
